- ▶ Highlights of program - Dave reviewed Carson County School District program - same grant so very similar.
 - ▶ Trainings
 - ▶ Liaisons conduct, school visits, one on one supervision, group supervision, and coaching.
 - ▶ Each Liaison has small team trainings/meetings monthly
 - ▶ Policy and procedure
 - ▶ Functional Behavior Analysis
 - ▶ Ways to support classrooms management
 - ▶ Working with parents/school/community

- ▶ Trainings Continued
- ▶ Once a quarter large group trainings
 - ▶ Sex-trafficking
 - ▶ Trauma, Resilience and Redemption
 - ▶ Professional Self-Care
 - ▶ Therapeutic Yoga in the school setting
 - ▶ Self-Injury
 - ▶ Community Resources

Clark County School District PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Approved as a Clinical Site
 - ▶ Developing School-Based Mental Health Services using Multi-Tier Systems of Support Model
 - ▶ Brief interventions 9-12 weeks
 - ▶ School Based Mental Health Team
 - ▶ Systems Theory - Student, School, Family, Community
 - ▶ 4 pilot schools
 - ▶ 2 schools sites have two SWxS one Clinical and one non-clinical
 - ▶ 2 school sites have one Clinical Intern

Clark County School District PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ 1 October
- ▶ Project SERV grant -
 - ▶ Trauma 101 training
 - ▶ 3 hour In-Service
 - ▶ 2,500 school staffed trained by Dec 2018
 - ▶ 6 Trainer of Trainers to continue training to CCSD long-term
 - ▶ Cognitive Behavioral Intervention for Trauma in Schools (CBITS) and Bounce Back - Clinical - 30 Trained
 - ▶ Support for Students Exposed to Trauma (SSET) - Nonclinical 40 Trained

 - ▶ Mojave HS
- ▶ Data collection
 - ▶ Using Infinite Campus - Launch on Sept. 4

Clark County School District Plans to further SSW/SSP

▶ Practicum Site

- ▶ Need to build capacity to meet the growing need
- ▶ Partnership with University of Nevada, Las Vegas and University of Nevada, Reno
- ▶ Agency Field Instructors and Preceptors
 - ▶ 17/18 - 30 practicum students
 - ▶ Hired - 13 for 18/19 school year
 - ▶ 18/19 - 22 practicum students

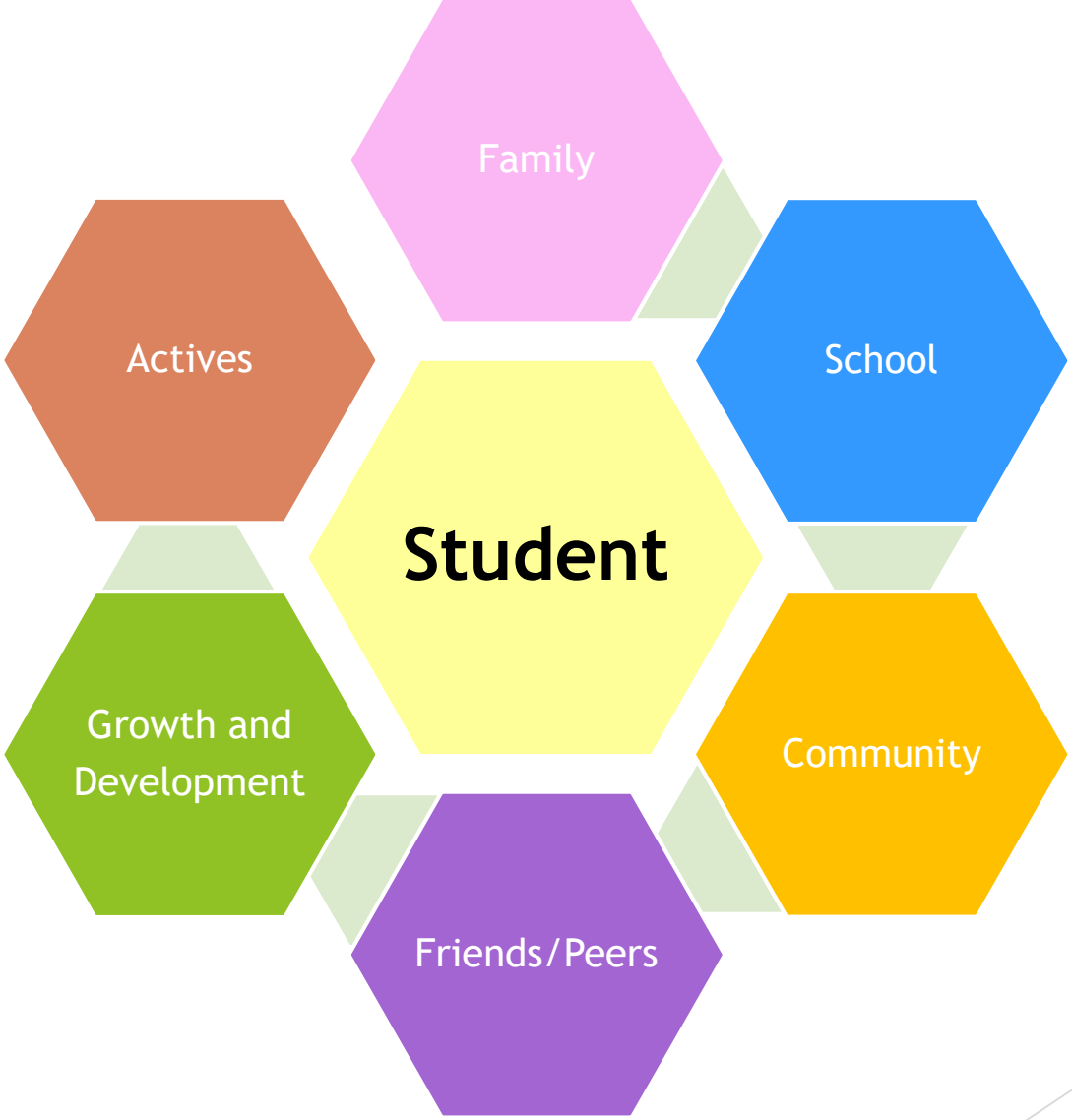

- ▶ Administrators

 - ▶ Mental Health needs
 - ▶ Physical/Medical needs

 - ▶ Immigration related needs
